- Financial Accounting
- Legal Environment of Business
- Macroeconomics
- Managerial Accounting
- Microeconomics
- Operations Management
- Principles of Finance
- Principles of Marketing

You may have completed some or all of these requirements as part of your undergraduate degree. Recent undergraduates with business majors typically will have completed all of the prerequisites. WSU Vancouver offers streamlined versions of these prerequisites as preparation for its MBA program. If you need foundation courses, speak with an academic coordinator before completing any foundation course work.

Class Schedule

The MBA program primarily serves working professionals pursuing their degree by taking evening courses on a part-time basis. WSU Vancouver operates on a semester system. Fall semester begins in late August and spring semester begins mid-January. Summer session classes start in May and June.

Admissions Requirements

To be eligible to apply for admission, you must have a baccalaureate degree (in any area) from an accredited college or university with at least 3.0 GPA in your last 60 semester credit hours, and must have successfully completed the Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) with a preferred minimum score of 550.

Admissions Priority Application Dates

March 1 – Summer semester

June 1 – Fall semester

October 1 – Spring semester

International students – January 10 for Fall semester and July 1 for Spring semester

Application Process

Step One: Complete the form. Complete the Graduate School application and admission payment form online at www.applyweb.com/apply/wsug.

The \$50 application fee must be paid using a Visa or Mastercard.

Step Two: Send official transcripts. Send one copy of official transcripts from each college previously attended to the Dean of the Graduate School, Washington State University, Pullman, WA 99164-1030. Official transcripts must be mailed directly from the college(s) previously attended to the Dean of the Graduate School at WSU.

Sealed official copies sent by the applicant are not acceptable.

Step Three: Send additional information to Vancouver MBA program at the address listed below.

- Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) scores (no more than five years old).
